

The insurance market continues to be challenging, with persistent rate increases and rising claims costs. Below is a summary of large verdicts and settlements \$10M+.

Description	AJD driver on I-95 was distracted by his cell phone, driving over the legal limit of hours, without a commercial driver's license, when he drove his truck into the back of a car trailered by an RV, causing the car to flip and burst into flames. AJD driver created a stall (hazard) in traffic. Kahkashan Carrier, also named in the lawsuit, drove into the back of decedent (Dzion), who was stopped. The Kahkashan driver was on cruise control going 70 MPH, data recorder showed no braking prior to one second before impact. The jury held AJD responsible for 10% of negligence in the cause of Dzion's death and held Kahkashan held responsible for 90%. Parents of the decedent were awarded \$86M from Kahkashan Carrier for compensatory damages and for emotional distress. The court ordered AJD Business Services to pay \$16M to Melissa Dzion (mother of decedent) while the punitive damages against the company totaled \$900M. The decedent was an 18-year-old male who had just started college.

The load was escorted by both front and back escort vehicles. Landstar settled a week prior to jury selection for \$50M. S&M Pilot Service settled prior trial for \$1M. Trial went forward against 2A Pilot Cars, and the jury awarded \$480M in compensatory damages and \$250M in punitive damages. Landstar did not own the truck or any of the equipment involved in the crash, and did not employ the driver operating the truck. The propeller was being hauled under Landstar's authority and the truck and trailing equipment were leased to Landstar by the truck's owner-operator.

FMCSA safety alerts flagged Lupus Superior for unsafe driving and hours of service violations, on the night of the accident the driver told Lupus Superior and C.H. Robinson he was too sick to drive. Jury found the driver 45%, Lupus Superior 32%, and C.H. Robinson 23%. The jury found C.H. Robinson vicariously liable for the driver adding an additional 45% for a total of 68%.

Her mother suffered a fractured neck, pelvis and ribs. The defendant driver refused testing, telling his manager that he would not test because there were drugs in his system. The police found methamphetamine residue in his truck. The same driver had completed a 24-hour shift driving a tractor-trailer (hours violation) prior to the collision. Stuart Petroleum entered into a Gasquet settlement with the plaintiffs, allowing them to pursue non-settling excess carriers. Westchester (Chubb) had \$15 million in excess coverage. The case was tried over four days and the jury deliberated for one hour. The jury found the defendant driver 10% at fault and Stuart Petroleum 90% at fault. The jury concluded that the defendant driver was intoxicated, and his conduct was wanton and reckless, triggering punitive damages.

Liability was layered across all three carriers, with Thunder Ridge and Fames facing exposure for negligent entrustment and the unauthorized delegation of a federally regulated transportation contract, and Montecristo bearing direct liability for placing a fatigued, non-compliant driver on the road.
